Swissgrid is entitled to adjust the tariffs within the framework of the legal and regulatory requirements. Swissgrid generally notifies grid users about tariffs in writing three months at the latest prior to the legally prescribed date of publication for grid operators

Additionally, no on-account billing rates apply for LTC holders (grid usage and loss of efficiency) from 2014 onwards, and no general ancillary service billing rate is used for power plants from 2011 onwards.
